ICIT (International Conference on Information Technology) is a premier international conference for high quality research in the area of Information Technology. ICIT 2008 is being jointly organized by the Orissa Information Technology Society (<http://www.oits.org>) and the Xavier Institute of Management, Bhubaneswar (<http://www.ximb.ac.in>) to be held at Bhubaneswar, India from 17-20 December 2008. Researchers and practitioners from academia and industry are invited to present their research findings on various topics related to Information Technology and its Applications. The conference proceedings will be published by IEEE CS Press.

CONFERENCE TRACKS: ICIT encourages submissions in all areas of information technology. However, the papers in the following tracks will be the primary focus. The submissions in each track could be on any of the topics listed, but are not limited to them.

Algorithms: Analysis and Design of exact and approximation algorithms, parallel and Distributed Algorithms.

Architecture and Programming Systems: Multi-cores, memory hierarchy, multiprocessor synchronization and debugging, concurrent programming, OS virtualization modeling and simulation, load balancing and partitioning, compiler techniques, application specific systems, hardware design, electronic design automation

Databases and Bioinformatics: Data warehousing, data mining, feature extraction, computational biology, modeling and visualization of biological data

Wireless and On-chip Networks: Wireless ad-hoc networks, sensor networks, network security, network-on-a-chip

Software Engineering and Industry Applications: Software architecture, requirements engineering, human-computer interface, software testing, and real time software.

Web Technology: Web services, search engine design, page ranking algorithms, web-page prediction, ontology, agent technology, crawler design

Management Information Systems: All areas of MIS.

PAPER SUBMISSION: Papers not exceeding six pages reporting high quality original and unpublished research are solicited for this conference. The papers need to be submitted online through the conference website indicated below. The submitted papers will undergo double-blind review by a strong team of reviewers and program committee members consisting of leading researchers around the globe. Depending on the merit of the paper, each accepted paper other than tutorial proposal will fall into one of the categories: Regular Paper, short paper and poster papers. An accepted paper will appear in the conference proceedings provided at least one of the authors of the paper registers for the conference. Tutorial presenters are requested to contact the tutorial chairs for the suitability of the topics and then submit a description of at most two pages to one of the tutorial chairs.

BEST PAPER AWARDS: The Amiya K. Pujari Award will be conferred on the Best Paper of the conference; the Narayan Misra Award on the best paper from Orissa; and one best student paper will be selected from the papers with students as the leading authors. The awards carry a cash prize and a citation.
